Before Creating a PDF

- Add the copyright notice to the bottom of the first page of your source document. If necessary, contact **Ken Hintz** at khintz@gmu.edu for the appropriate copyright notice. Add the copyright notice to the bottom of the first page of your source document. If necessary, contact **Mike McDonald** at mike.mcdonald@drdc-rddc.gc.ca for the appropriate copyright notice.
- Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.

Creating your PDF eXpress Account

Log in to the [IEEE PDF eXpress](#)™ site

First-time users should do the following:

1. Select the New Users - Click Here link.
2. Enter the following:
 - **43075X** for the Conference ID
 - your email address
 - a password
3. Continue to enter information as prompted.

An Online confirmation will be displayed and an email confirmation will be sent verifying your account setup.

Previous users of PDF eXpress need to follow the above steps, but should enter the same password that was used for previous conferences. Verify that your contact information is valid.
